

## **Policy Title: Access to Typical Facilities** (Policy ATF)

- 1. Non-Residential Settings (e.g., Day Programs, Community Centers)
  - a. Policy ensures individuals can:
    - i. Freely access common areas like lounges, cafeterias, and activity rooms
    - ii. Participate in community-based activities without unnecessary restrictions
    - iii. Make choices about who they interact with and what they do
    - iv. Be treated with respect and equality, regardless of disability status
    - v. These settings must also comply with HCBS standards, ensuring that individuals are not isolated and have full access to the broader community.
- 2. Training Components for Staff
  - a. Rights-Based Education
  - b. Understanding the legal and ethical foundations of individual rights
  - c. Familiarity with HCBS Final Rule and person-centered planning principles
- 3. Practical Implementation
  - a. How to support access to shared spaces respectfully
  - b. Strategies for balancing safety with autonomy
  - c. Recognizing and avoiding institutional practices (e.g., unnecessary restrictions)
- 4. Communication & Advocacy
  - a. Encouraging individuals to express preferences
  - b. Responding to concerns or complaints appropriately
  - c. Advocating for environmental or procedural changes when access is limited
